Mr. Janis began working with The Bloom Organization in August 2008. Mr. Janis is an experienced project manager with expertise in planning, project management, strategy development and execution.

For the last 10 years, prior to joining the Bloom Organization, Mr. Janis was Director, Acquisitions and Analysis for NovaMed, Inc. At NovaMed, Mr. Janis was primarily responsible for the valuation, financial analysis and due diligence related to the acquisition and development of single-specialty and multi-specialty ambulatory surgery centers. In this capacity, he participated in the closing of 16 physician clinic transactions, 16 ambulatory surgery center acquisitions and 7 various other transactions (ASC builds, ASC syndications, optical lab business and optical buying group). Many of these transactions related to ophthalmology and optometric practices as well as single-specialty ophthalmology surgery centers as NovaMed was founded as an eye care services company. In total, these transactions encompassed over \$91 million in purchase price, \$76 million in annual revenue and added 180 physicians to NovaMed. In addition, Mr. Janis prepared and periodically updated financial model information for divestitures of physician practices as NovaMed exited the physician practice management business and continued its focus on the ambulatory surgery center market.

Prior to joining NovaMed, Mr. Janis was an Associate with the Healthcare Consulting Group of BDO Seidman, LLP. In this role, Mr. Janis managed various engagements related to financial and Medicare reimbursement strategy and analysis. Clients ranged from hospital-based and freestanding skilled nursing facilities, home health agencies, and physician groups.
